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## INTRODUCTION TO THE WICIT

The Word In Context Intelligibility Test (WICIT) was originally developed in 1995 as a test to quantify use of linguistic context by hearing impaired listeners. It includes highpredictability (HP) sentences and zero-predictability (ZP) sentences. HP sentences are context-rich four-word sentences. For example: "Feet have five toes." ZP sentences are meaningless four-word combinations. For example: "Red June hay paint." The WICIT consists of 4 HP lists with 20 sentences (Lists 1A-4A) and four ZP lists with 20 sentences (List 1B-4B). The four ZP lists were constructed by randomizing the words within each HP list. In addition, there are 15 HP practice sentences and 15 ZP practice sentences.

## AUDIO FILE DOWNLOAD

Audio files in .wav formats are available on www.harlmemphis.org Long-term RMS levels of calibration signal, masking noise, and sentences were digitally equalized. All the audio files are stereo files (Table 1).

## SCORING METHOD

The test is administered by playing one sentence at a time. The listener is instructed to repeat the sentence to the examiner. Each word is scored as correct or incorrect. Each word must be repeated exactly to be scored as correct. Subjects who repeat the test words incorrectly for number or tense are not given credit for being partially correct. The proportion of correctly repeated words is computed for each list. There are 80 test words per list.

## Instructions for the WICIT in masking noise

## For HP lists:

You will hear a woman's voice saying some sentences. You also are going to hear some noise playing at the same time. Each sentence has 4 words. Please repeat each sentence the woman says back to me exactly as you hear it. Sometimes, it might be difficult to understand what she says. Try your best to repeat as much of each sentence as you can. It is ok to guess.

## For ZP lists:

You will hear a woman's voice saying lists of 4 words in a background of noise. Please repeat each list of 4 words the woman says back to me exactly as you hear it.
Sometimes, it might be difficult to understand what she says. Try your best to repeat as many of the words as you can. It is ok to guess.
